The Board of Medical Practice will release on its website only the Disciplinary Actions which were taken on or which have occurred since the most recent Board Meeting Date. Also, please take note of the statute regarding information the Board must publish. For questions regarding any other Disciplinary Actions, please contact the Board of Medical Practice at (612) 617-2130. Minnesota Statute 147.02 Subd. 6. Disciplinary actions must be published. At least annually, the board shall publish and release to the public a description of all disciplinary measures taken by the board. The publication must include, for each disciplinary measure taken, the name and business address of the licensee, the nature of the misconduct, and the disciplinary measure taken by the board. Minnesota Statute 147.02 Subd. 6a. Exception to publication requirement. The publication requirement does not apply to disciplinary measures by the board which are based exclusively upon grounds listed in section 147.091, subdivision 1, clause (l) or (r).

2. She is prohibited from prescribing Schedule I through V controlled substances until she has successfully completed the following, pre-approved, courses. The courses must be completed within six months:
  - a. Chemical dependency awareness.
  - b. Chronic pain management.
  - c. Professional boundaries.
3. Upon successful completion of the required coursework, she may submit a petition for reinstatement of her narcotic prescribing privileges.
4. Six months after resuming the prescribing of narcotics, she shall submit to a random audit of her prescribing practices.
5. She shall maintain a daily log of all controlled substance prescriptions. The log shall be made available for monthly review by her supervising physician and for quarterly review by her designated Board member.
6. She shall practice in a pre-approved group setting.
7. She shall meet monthly with a pre-approved supervising physician who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
8. She shall meet quarterly with a designated Board member.
9. She shall pay a \$4,994 civil penalty within six months.
10. This Order shall remain in effect for a minimum of two years.

4. She shall practice in a pre-approved group setting.
5. She shall meet monthly with a pre-approved supervising physician who shall submit quarterly reports to the Board.
6. She shall develop, and submit for approval by the Committee, a written protocol for the management and tracking of controlled substance prescriptions, including refills.

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7. She shall develop, and submit for approval by the Committee, a contract for use with patients who receive controlled substances for the treatment of chronic pain.
8. She shall meet on a quarterly basis with a designated Board member.
9. She shall pay a civil penalty of \$4279 within six months.
